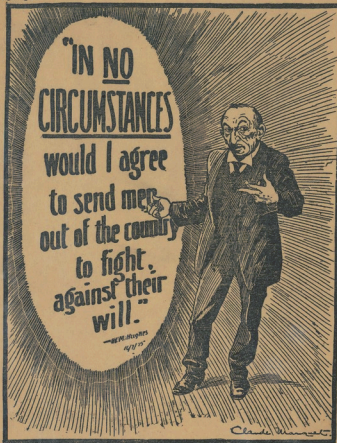


PLEASE PASTE UP.
