3. STUDY PLAN

The following information is intended to help you structure your Honours program. Honours students must complete the program requirements for their discipline as per the program course list approved by the Executive Dean and the Head of School.

Students commencing Honours from Semester 1, 2025 onwards undertake 16 (sixteen) units, comprising a research thesis (12 units) and coursework (4 units). For the coursework component, students have a choice of three Research Design courses, as set out below. Supervisors must approve the choice of Research Design course.

The Study Plan is structured depending on whether Honours is undertaken part-time or full-time and the commencing semester. The following table provides possible Study Plans for students commencing in semester 1 2025. For any changes to Study Plan after approval, such as changes from full-time to part-time, please email admin-hapi@uq.edu.au.
